Year 9-10

Aim: To give students an overview

of the science undertaken in Scion and the importance of trees to New Zealand and the Forestry industry.

Delivery: 2-hour tour for a maximum

of 25 students (one class).

Content: Tours may include: Forestry

protection laboratory activity, Nursery tour, Scion grounds tour, Scion employees talk, Wood qualities and classification activity.

Career day / School based stall

Aim: To provide further

understanding of what Scion does and the possible careers available within the forestry sector, we could send someone to attend your career day.

Delivery:

One stall with a wood classification activity and a few Scion employees to talk with students about forestry and the career options available in scientific and biomaterials research and forestry.

Year 11-13

Aim: To give students an experience

of what science research is underway at Scion / what jobs in particular fields could be available in the forestry sector.

Delivery: 1.5-3 hour tour for a max of

25 students (one class).

Content: Could include a particular

focus on: Chemistry, Biology, Horticulture, Mathematics, Physics, and associated careers within the forestry sector. Content will be dependent on staff availability.

What you need to know

Bookings need to be made at least a month in advance, as limited openings for tours are available.

- Students and adults attending must all wear covered-in footwear
- Upon arrival Someone will meet you at the specified time in the reception area of the Scion building located at the end of Titokorangi Drive, (formerly Longmile road).
- While on Scion grounds you remain responsible for your students.

To take advantage of a tour to Scion you will need to provide us with:

- A teacher/ adult to student attendance ratio (minimum 1:15)
- Any specific disability or accessibility requirements prior to booking.


